The ATCO Indigenous Education Awards Program recognizes Indigenous students who demonstrate leadership capabilities and strive to be role models in their school and communities. Since the program began in 2011, 240 students have received financial support from ATCO to assist with their education.

We ask for your assistance in promoting this program to your students.

There are three different categories and multiple awards available to Indigenous students:

- Merit Awards of \$500 for students completing grades 10-12, including upgrading
- Bursaries of \$1,000 for students registered in a trade, community, or technical college diploma program
- Scholarships of \$1,500 for university or graduate degree students

The awards are presented to select students who demonstrate leadership capabilities and commitment in their quest for higher education. To be considered for an award, students must complete the online application form and submit the required documentation, including:

- Reference letter
- Proof of enrollment for their upcoming school semester
- Short Essay [500-1,000 words]
- Transcript from the most recent school attended
